Community health educators provide real-time instruction to students through video conferencing equipment.

Prisma Health's educational component for school-based telehealth provides students with relevant and interactive content to support improved behaviors and overall knowledge of nutrition and physical activity.

The "Eat Well, Keep Moving" curriculum focuses on obesity prevention and reduction and is provided for 16 weeks in afterschool programming.

The educational component of telehealth is fully operational in Richland and Sumter county schools. A clinical component is available during school hours.
